Rubber granules: Slats are optional on dog walk and teeter. Slats are required on the aframe. ONLY when rubber granules are used, slats do not need to be in the contact zones on the aframe, they must be above the contact zone to the top of the apex (or plank on dog walk/teeter). See www.cleanrun.com for the "wet apply" rubber granule method recommended by CPE. Full details in the CPE rulebook – obstacle specifications, also for the interior non-slip surface for the chute barrel.
