* The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.

* It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

* Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.

Exhibitors not attending the Judge's briefing will still be held responsible for knowing the terms and conditions set forth in these briefings.

There will be no measuring of dogs after the Judge's briefing begins each day – all dogs without a permanent card must be measured before the Judge's briefing to show that day.

PRIZES & AWARDS: Placement ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place for qualifying scores for all classes. Dogs with an NT (no time) are not eligible for ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score; orange Junior Handler ribbons will be awarded for a qualifying score in Standard. See "Ribbon" section below for additional details.

Exercise your dog responsibly. Please pick up after your dog at the show site and hotels. All dogs must be on leash except when in the ring or warm-up area. Retractable style leashes are not permitted in the building or within 100 feet of the buildings at BVTC. There is a leash law in Pennsylvania.

OBSTACLES: The following obstacles may be used. Obstacle specifications shall meet the current CPE obstacle requirements

Aframe – 9' sides, rubber granules, slats	Dog Walk – 12' planks, rubber granules, slats
Teeter – 12' plank, rubber granules, slatless	Weave poles – 24" poles - center to center
Jumps: Bar, Spread, Panel	Open Tunnels

CPE trial rules – shortened version: see the online rulebook at www.k9cpe.com for registration info, “Registering with CPE” and further info on height categories and rules.

Jump Heights – no dog will jump lower than 4”

P-Card = Permanent Card: the lowest allowable Regular height a dog may jump in CPE.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 15 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries. Registration forms are on the Forms page: www.k9cpe.com. Forms MUST be mailed to CPE and are processed 2-3 times per week. CPE ID numbers are emailed to legible email addresses. Registrations can only be processed from mailed forms.
- Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run and no refund will be issued. Dogs within ½” of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- Only CPE Judges can measure dogs.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: collars, stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog’s eyes.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.
- Handlers may not carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, an NT will result. Exception: Handicapped handlers that have a mobility problem in picking up the leash at the finish may put their leash in their pocket – the leash must be out of sight.

- Dogs must be under the handler’s control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.

Declared Training In the Ring

We (Bella Rose Group) will offer Declared training in the ring. The handler has the option if they want to use a toy or training aid at any time during their run, the handler must approach the Judge during Walkthrough or previously in that trial day for the Judge to approve the toy or training aid for use on the course.

- Handler must alert the Judge upon entry to the ring that the dog will be TIR. Handler is then allowed to have a reasonably sized silent toy/aid with them for use once their run has started (this toy must be approved by the Judge of record PRIOR to the start of the class to determine its eligibility, absolutely no food/scents/audible devices). The toy is NOT allowed to be used in either gate chute or prior to the previous dog leaving the ring.

The following items *are* considered training in the ring (see Fix and Go):

- Violating the 4 paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact)
- Start line stay – leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

While running on course

- The handler will direct the dog through the course without a collar or lead.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10’ feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.

The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5 fault penalty to elimination for any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be, but are not limited to: foul or abusive language, display of anger, extreme frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and / or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE. See Faults, Eliminations and Excusals in the rulebook.

Trial & Site-specific information

The site: This site is privately owned. Please keep your dogs on leash and clean up after them, placing waste in the outdoor cans provided. Don't allow your dogs to urinate on buildings, plants, cones, or anything that must be touched (including trash cans). **All BVTC policies are in effect.** Please see the website at www.bvtrainingcenter.com for more information.

Arrival/Start times: The building will be open at 7:00 AM on all trial days. If the trial does not fill, the start/facility opening times may be adjusted for a later start.

Refunds: Entries withdrawn prior to the closing date are subject to a \$5 administrative fee per dog. Withdrawals after the closing date due to injury of the dog will be eligible for a 75% refund of entry fees paid upon receipt of a note from your veterinarian. The note must be dated and emailed or mailed to the Trial Secretary and Chairperson by noon on the Monday following the trial. No refunds for bitches in season. If you have questions, contact the Trial Chairperson directly at trialec@bvtrainingcenter.com

Administrative Reminders: If you provide your email address, we will acknowledge receipt of your entry via email within a few days. If you do not have email but want us to confirm receipt of your entry, please include a SASE with your entry. Please double-check your entry form and remember to sign the Release Form. A \$35.00 service charge will be added for any returned checks.

Move-ups: Please provide your CPE number, name, dog's name, class moving from/to by email to the Trial Secretary for pre-trial move-ups prior to noon on February 21, 2022. We will accept day-to-day move-ups at this trial which must be submitted by filling out a form in the "Move-Up Book" within 20 minutes after the end of the last class each day.

Food: Allen's Eatery has delivery available. Menus will be posted.

Crating: All crating for exhibitors will be in the Annex Building. The Annex is heated/air conditioned. Clean tarps must be placed under all crates. No ex-pens without prior written approval from BVTC.

Handicapped Parking: Handicapped parking spots are marked. Anyone parking in a handicapped spot without a current handicapped license plate/placard will be towed at the owner's expense.

Ribbons: Ribbons will be self-serve, except for the Level C and Junior Handler Q ribbons which will be maintained behind the secretary table. We also have **New Title** ribbons for any dog earning a new title and a new championship title. In addition, "Perfect Weekend" Ribbons will be available. To earn a Perfect Weekend Ribbon the team must be entered in a minimum of 8 classes and Q in all entered classes. **With advance notice, this club will offer a jump bar for any C-ATCH or C-ATE title earned. C-ATCH and C-ATE Ribbons will also be provided.**

DIRECTIONS:

I-83 to Exit 32 (Newberrytown exit). At the light at the bottom of the ramp, turn left onto Rt. 382 North to Lewisberry. Go approximately 3 miles to the flashing traffic light and turn left onto Rt. 177 South toward Rossville. Go approximately 3 miles and turn right on Mt. Airy Rd. (across from Lake Pinchot Park Office). Continue approximately 1.7 miles to the site on the left.

US-15 to Mechanicsburg and take the Bowmansdale exit, Rt. 114 towards Ski Roundtop, At the traffic light at the bottom of the hill, proceed straight on South Market Street. DO NOT FOLLOW 114. Continue straight about 2.3 miles on South Market St. which will become North York Rd. Turn left on East Mt. Airy Rd (at Mt. Pleasant Church of God) and go approximately 4.5 miles. You will pass Ski Roundtop on the right. Continue to a "T" intersection and turn right on Pinetown Rd. Take the first Left onto Mt. Airy Road. Site is immediately on the right.
