Entry Method – First Received: No opening date. Entries may be mailed/received at any time once the premium has been published Overnight envelopes must have the recipient’s signature waiver signed or the envelope may be refused or delayed.
Entries close – February 17, 2021 at 6 p.m. or upon trial filling No Refund of Pre-Entries withdrawn after the closing date UNLESS LOCATION IS CHANGED (SEE NOTE under GENERAL INFORMATION).
Final Move-Up Closing Date: March 3, 2021 – 8 p.m. Tucson Time
Run Limit – 375 runs per judge Allowing training in the ring
DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES: 7:15 – 7:30 a.m. Saturday and Sunday. Day of Show Entries are \$2 more per run than listed on the entry form
If the limit is reached for any/both days by the closing date, February 17, 2021, Desert Dawg Sports will contact CPE to have FULL posted to the CPE events page, for any day(s) that have reached the 375 runs per day limit. GENERAL INFORMATION – PLEASE READ ABOUT CHANGES BELOW!!!!!!!!!!!!

NOTE: Due to Pima County and/or Tucson COVID restrictions, the Trial site MAY be changed to Raven Ranch (RR). Raven Ranch site is a large covered horse arena, with packed dirt surface (see Directions below). Bring shade for you and your dog along with chairs and crates. Food or WATER will be NOT provided by the club given current COVID restrictions for physical distancing. More information will be sent and if a site change is required, you will be notified at least TWO (2) WEEKS IN ADVANCE, PLUS you will be given the chance to cancel your entry with no penalty. Email confirmations will be sent upon receipt, and again upon processing of your entry. Please review your confirmation carefully and send any corrections in immediately. Retain your confirmation and bring along to the show – copies will not be mailed.

Directions to Show Site:

From I-19: Go North on I-19 to I-10 Pearl Harbor Memorial Highway to Exit 255. Take exit towards AZ-77 N/Miracle Mile and turn right onto Miracle Mile. Follow Miracle Mile to Oracle Road and turn left. Then turn right onto West Fort Lowell. Follow Ft. Lowell to North Dodge Blvd. Then turn left onto Dodge Blvd. Follow Dodge Blvd to North Alvernon Way, then turn left at the first cross street onto E River Road then go 302 feet and the park will be on the left.

From I-10 E: Go South on I-10 to Exit 250 Orange Grove Road. Then turn left onto Orange Grove Road. Follow Orange Grove Road to W River Road. Turn right onto River Road and follow it for approximately 9 miles and then the park will be on the right.

Raven Ranch Site: Take I-10 East from Tucson or I-19; (or Take I-10 West from Benson) to Houghton Rd (exit 275). Go north 7 miles on Houghton Rd to Irvington Rd. Take a left (west) onto Irvington Rd for 1 mile to Harrison Rd. Go right (north) on Harrison for approximately ½ mile to the NORTH entrance to Raven Ranch parking area, ¼ mile past the covered arena. Park in open area. Do **NOT** park next to arena!!!

TRAINING IN THE RING IS
NOW ALLOWED!

Jump Heights – no dog will jump lower than 4”

P-Card = Permanent Card: the lowest allowable Regular height a dog may jump in CPE.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- ✿ Dogs must be at least 15 months or older the first day of the trial
- ✿ Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- ✿ Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries. Registration is now through member services at <https://www.k9cpe.com/memberservices>. An email address is required for membership. Requests must be received before Wednesday 4:00 PM EST to be eligible to enter that week’ trials that have Day of Show entries. If you have questions about online registration or your membership, please email Sean at sean@cpe.dog
- ✿ Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run and no refund will be issued. Dogs within ½” of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- ✿ Only CPE Judges can measure dogs.
- ✿ Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- ✿ Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- ✿ Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: collars, stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog’s eyes.
- ✿ Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- ✿ Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.
- ✿ Handlers may not carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, an NT will result. Exception: Handicapped handlers that have a mobility problem in picking up the leash at the finish may put their leash in their pocket – the leash must be out of sight.
- ✿ Dogs must be under the handler’s control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.

For clubs that will allow Declared Training In the Ring

- ✿ We (Desert Dawgs) will offer Declared training in the ring. The handler has the option if they want to use a toy or training aid at any time during their run, the handler must approach the Judge during Walkthrough or previously in that trial day for the Judge to approve the toy or training aid for use on the course.
- ✿ Handler must alert the Judge upon entry to the ring that the dog will be TIR. Handler is then allowed to have a reasonably sized silent toy/aid with them for use once their run has started (this toy must be approved by the Judge of record PRIOR to the start of the class to determine its eligibility, absolutely no food/scents/audible devices). The toy is NOT allowed to be used in either gate chute or prior to the previous dog leaving the ring.
- ✿ See the online rulebook or current member letter for additional rules. The following items *are* considered training in the ring (see Fix andGo):
- ✿ Violating the 4 paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto thecontact)
- ✿ Start line stay – leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- ✿ Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

While running on course

- ✿ The handler will direct the dog through the course without a collar or lead.
- ✿ Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10’ feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- ✿ The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.
- ✿ The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5 fault penalty to elimination for any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be but are not limited to: foul or abusive language, display of anger, extreme frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and / or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- ☛ The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- ☛ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.

- ☛ It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- ☛ No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- ☛ Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms: illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.

Jumps: Bar, Spread, Panel, Broad	Open Tunnels	Pause Table – games only



AWARDS AND PRIZES



Placement rosettes or ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place for qualifying and non-qualifying scores for all classes. Dogs with NT [no time] are not eligible for any ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score, and Jr Handlers in Standard.

EXERCISE YOUR DOG RESPONSIBLY! PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG AT THE SHOW SITE AND HOTELS! ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR WARM UP AREA. THERE IS A LEASH LAW IN THE TRIAL SITE’S STATE.

MEASURING& CHECK IN INFO FOR THE TRIAL

Measure and check in will start at 7:15 AM each morning, and first dog on the line will be at 8 AM, depending on the weather. If temperatures are near freezing, some delays may occur for you and your dog(s)’ safety. **THERE WILL BE NO MEASURING OF DOGS AFTER 8 AM each day.** ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT CARD MUST BE MEASURED BEFORE THE JUDGE’S BRIEFING TO SHOW THAT DAY. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.

Don't worry if you haven't volunteered before – we'll show you how to do your job!

Job Descriptions

Scribe: The scribe marks the faults or points as directed by the judge. You must be able to pay full attention to the judge and not the dog during a run.

Timer: The timer starts and stops the timer as the dog crosses the start/finish line.

Gate Steward: Ensures dogs and handlers are ready at the start line and helps the scribe and/or assistant scribe match the running order on the gate steward sheets.

Ring Crew: Resets jump bars for height changes and when knocked down. This job usually allows you to sit down and watch the dogs run.

Runner: Takes the scribe sheet from the scribe and gives it to the score table and/or moves the leash from the start line to the finish line. A great job for the new exhibitor as it allows you to watch the dogs run while you work. May require substantial walking and bending.

Course Builder: Moves obstacles as directed by the judge and/or chief course builder. This is a great way to learn how to set a course.

A veterinarian's notice of injury or illness will be required for a refund. Bitches which come in season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid. A veterinarian's notice is required.
