

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- * Read updated rules section and Covid-19 recommendations/waiver!
- * We are holding this trial strictly within the requirements for COVID Agricultural Events within Washington State & the current Phase of Thurston County.
- * The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- * Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.
- * It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- * No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- * Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms: illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.
- * Checks will be held until closing date. Checks not honored by bank do not constitute a valid entry. A \$25 fee will be charged on returned checks.

Refund Policy: A 100% refund will be given for withdrawals received before closing date. After closing and up until 48 hours before the trial, refunds – less a \$25 handling fee – will be given for the following: bitches in heat, injured or ill dogs (with verification from vet on request), injured or ill handlers (with verification upon request), or family emergency.

CAMPING: Limited Electric Hook-up Only facilities are available for \$25 per night, these are first come first serve. Camping with no hookups is \$10 a night. Camping fees can be included in your entry fee check for this trial.

CONFIRMATIONS: Will be sent via email. To ensure you receive your confirmation, please allow topdogcpe@gmail.com through your SPAM filter! Final confirmations will be emailed the week before the trial, please read that email as additional information will be included.

DIRECTIONS:

From I-5 heading North: Take exit #95, WA-121 toward Littlerock/Maytown. At end of ramp, turn left onto Maytown Road toward Littlerock. At intersection, turn right on Maytown Road, go 900 feet (past Farm Boy Restaurant) and turn right onto Case Road SW. At end of road (2 miles), turn left onto 113th Ave SW. In 0.8 miles, turn right into Flying M Stables (3922 113th Ave SW). Follow drive to the left, observe speed limit please. Arena is at the end of drive.

From I-5 heading South: Take exit #95, WA-121 toward Littlerock/Maytown. Ramp will turn into Maytown Road, follow it toward Littlerock (past Farm Boy Restaurant) and turn right onto Case Road SW. Follow the directions above to Flying M Stables.

Walk-Through and Starting Times

Briefing will be emailed!! Walk-through will begin at 1:30 PM on Friday with first dog on the line at 2 PM. Walk-throughs on Saturday and Sunday will begin at 7:30 AM each day and the first class will begin at 8:00 AM each day.

PRIZES & AWARDS: If you are not going to keep the ribbons, please do not take any – ribbons cannot be recycled at this time. Ribbon labels may or may not be utilized at this time. Placement rosettes or ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place for Qualifying and non-qualifying scores for all classes. Dogs with an NT (no time) are not eligible for any ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score, and Jr Handlers in Standard.

CPE trial rules – shortened version: see the online rulebook at www.k9cpe.com for registration info, “Registering with CPE” and further info on height categories and rules.

Jump Heights – no dog will jump lower than 4”

P-Card = Permanent Card: the lowest allowable Regular height a dog may jump in CPE.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 15 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries. Registration forms are on the Forms page: www.k9cpe.com. Forms MUST be mailed to CPE and are processed 2-3 times per week. CPE ID numbers are emailed to legible email addresses. Registrations can only be processed from mailed forms.
- Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run and no refund will be issued. Dogs within ½” of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- Only CPE Judges can measure dogs.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: collars, stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog’s eyes.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.
- Handlers may not carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, an NT will result. Exception: Handicapped handlers that have a mobility

problem in picking up the leash at the finish may put their leash in their pocket – the leash must be out of sight.

- Dogs must be under the handler’s control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.

For clubs that will allow Declared Training In the Ring

We, Top Dog, will offer Declared training in the ring. The handler has the option if they want to use a toy or training aid at any time during their run, the handler must approach the Judge during Walkthrough or previously in that trial day for the Judge to approve the toy or training aid for use on the course.

- Handler must alert the Judge upon entry to the ring that the dog will be TIR. Handler is then allowed to have a reasonably sized silent toy/aid with them for use once their run has started (this toy must be approved by the Judge of record PRIOR to the start of the class to determine its eligibility, absolutely no food/scents/audible devices). The toy is NOT allowed to be used in either gate chute or prior to the previous dog leaving the ring.

See the online rulebook or current member letter for additional rules.

The following items *are* considered training in the ring (see Fix and Go):

- Violating the 4 paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact)
- Start line stay – leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

While running on course

- The handler will direct the dog through the course without a collar or lead.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10’ feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.

The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5 fault penalty to elimination for any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be but are not limited to: foul or abusive language, display of anger, extreme frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and / or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE. See Faults, Eliminations and Excusals in the rulebook.

Please be aware that currently, it is up to you to maintain physical distancing guidelines when catching up with friends and talking about the course etc. Be aware these precautions may lead to a longer day than previously experienced vs the entries received.

If you are ill, please stay home. If the club deems an exhibitor ill at the event, they have the option to excuse that exhibitor. Refunds will be given if you are ill.

MASKS: Masks are to be worn by anyone within the ring (building, walking, running, judging). Masks are up to the individual, club, local, state and government guidelines when not within the ring. Exhibitors who will be wearing masks will need to bring enough masks for the duration of the trial and dispose of single use masks properly. Make sure your dog is ok with people wearing masks. We don't want a dog becoming fearful due to something they've never seen before. CPE may re-evaluate this prior to the trial.

FOOD: There will be no food provided for competitors at this trial. Please bring food and water to the trial.

CRATING: The crating will be by assignment. Please attach a note to your entry stating you wish a crating spot. Preference will go to people who volunteer to work. We ask that if you can, please crate from your car.

LEASHES: Dogs must still run naked. All handlers have the choice to put their leash in their pocket or safely loop it around their waist or neck, it does not have to be out of the dog's sight, however, if the dog plays with it during the run, it would be considered a toy. If the handler cannot carry their leash, leashes will be dropped on the ground/floor at the start line and the leash runner will pick it up with a gripper device and place it at the exit gate on a chair or the ground/floor. Do not loop leashes on the ring barrier.

We are holding this trial strictly within the requirements for COVID Agricultural Events within Washington State and within the current phase for Thurston County.
