

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

* The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.

* A withdrawal from the test after closing date due to an injury and/or illness to the dog or for bitches which come into season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund of 75% of the total entry fee paid. A letter from your veterinarian is required

* It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

* Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms: illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION - PLEASE READ! MAILING YOUR ENTRIES

- Entries may not be postmarked before January 26, 2010
- Entries received before the postmark date will be destroyed
- No entries can be accepted without a legible postmark date.
- **All envelopes will be held for 7 days to allow for mail delivery. In the event that the trial limit is exceeded during the 7 days, entries will then be processed in postmark date order. A random draw will then be done from the entries for the postmark date when the limit will be reached. Volunteers get first preference**

Jump Heights – no dog will jump lower than 4"

P-Card = Permanent Card: the lowest allowable Regular height a dog may jump in CPE.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 15 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries. Registration forms are on the Forms page: www.k9cpe.com. Forms MUST be mailed to CPE and are processed 2-3 times per week. CPE ID numbers are emailed to legible email addresses. Registrations can only be processed from mailed forms.
- Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run and no refund will be issued. Dogs within 1/2" of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- Only CPE Judges can measure dogs.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: collars, stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog's eyes.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.
- Handlers may not carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, an NT will result. Exception: Handicapped handlers that have a mobility problem in picking up the leash at the finish may put their leash in their pocket – the leash must be out of sight.
- Dogs must be under the handler's control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.

Training a dog in the ring during a run

There is no training in the ring at a CPE agility trial. First offense will result in an excusal from the run. Further offenses will result in additional excusals for the day/weekend per the judge's discretion. This is for the safety of the dog.

The following items *are not* considered training in the ring (also see FEO):

- Dog grabbing it's leash at the end of a run (if the run has not yet ended, the dog would receive an NT)
- Asking the dog once for a sit or down on the table in the point games (asking more than once will be a delay of finish, 5 faults/points)

The following items *are* considered training in the ring:

- Violating the 4 paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact)
- Start line stay – leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

While running on course

- The handler will direct the dog through the course without a collar or lead.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10' feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.

The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5 fault penalty to elimination for any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be, but are not limited to: foul or abusive language, display of anger, extreme frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and / or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE. See Faults, Eliminations and Excusals in the rulebook.

SITE INFORMATION

- There will be set up on Friday night. The training center will be open at 6.45a.m. on Saturday the 13th.
- Building is a 2 story walk up. Is heated but tends to be chilly, dressing in layers is suggested.
- Please park as directed by the trial officials. To assist with parking please car pool if possible.
- There is a designated "potty" area. Please clean up after your dog and place waste in the receptacles provided by the club. **Do not** use any dumpster or allow dogs to urinate on buildings.
- **Crating space is extremely limited.** Please do not bring dogs that are not competing into the building. Our parking lot is a safe area. No ex-pens.
- Snacks and beverages will not be on sale. There are numerous food vendors within a minutes drive.
- **Consumption of alcoholic beverages or smoking is not permitted on the grounds.**

VERY IMPORTANT Parking and Pooping Rules

- **Park in the parking lot only.** As you enter the gates there is a small parking area - **under no circumstances are you permitted to park there** - continue around to your right and there are some additional spaces (you may park in those, but it is not preferred). You should park toward the green sheds and the building which has the brick chimney.

The grassy area above the parking lot (behind the long red brick building) is our designated potty area. Your dog is allowed to relieve himself only in that area. Dogs must not be allowed to urinate on stock or pallets in the roadway areas. All droppings (your dog or someone else's) must be picked up. We are a "carry in carry out" facility. **Do not use dumpsters in the complex - they do not belong do us.**

NOTE—Commercial vehicles/Trailers are not permitted on the Palisades Parkway

From The Northbound Palisades Parkway:

Take PIP north to exit 13. At the end of the ramp, bear right. At the first light, turn left onto Rte 202 East for approx. 2 miles. You will eventually pass a big ShopRite on your left, then the road goes downhill to a traffic light- at this light, turn left onto Main St. At the next light, turn right onto Railroad Ave. Continue straight thru the flashing light and pass a long white warehouse on the right – at the far end of the warehouse, turn right into the Garnerville Industrial Center. After parking, stand with your back to the main gate. The road passes between

two warehouses. Walk down this road, Skyline is the second building on the right and we are upstairs.

From The Southbound Palisades Parkway:

Take PIP south to exit 13, turn left onto Rte 202 East and proceed as above.

For Commercial Vehicles:

Take route 9W north towards Haverstraw. You will cross Rte. 202 and continue on 9W past all the fast food outlets. After passing KFC on the right, turn left at the next light onto Railroad Ave. At the top of the hill, turn left into Garnerville Industrial Center and proceed as above.
