- * The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- * Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.
- * It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- * No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- * Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms: illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.

THESE WILL BE NO MEASURING OF DOGS AFTER JUDGE'S BRIEFING BEGINS EACH DAY - ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT CARD MUST BE MEASURED BEFORE THE JUDGES BRIEFING TO SHOW THAT DAY - THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS

PRIZES & AWARDS: Placement rosettes or ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place for Qualifying and non-qualifying scores for all classes. Dogs with an NT (no time) are not eligible for any ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score, and Jr. Handlers in Standard.

EXERCISE YOUR DOG RESPONSIBLY! PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG AT THE SHOW SITE AND HOTELS! ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR WARM UP AREA. THERE IS A LEASH LAW IN THE TRIAL SITE'S STATE.

OBSTACLES: The following obstacles may be used. Obstacle specifications shall meet the current CPE obstacle requirements

Aframe – 9' sides, rubber granules, slats	Dog Walk – 12' planks, rubber granules, slats
Teeter – 12' plank, rubber granules, slatless	Weave poles – 24" poles - center to center
Jumps: Bar, Spread, Panel	Open Tunnels

Trials run smoother with your help! ☺ We will be looking for volunteers to help at our trial and coupons for future trials will be given. Sign up for jobs will be via an online document, about a week before the trial. Here are descriptions of the various volunteer jobs. The jobs are easy, so don't worry if you've never done this before. We'll be happy to teach you. Trials simply can't run without volunteer workers. You'll learn a lot, and the day will go faster!

Scribe: Makes sure the scribe sheets are in the correct order prior to the start of the class. Record faults or points for each dog, as directed by the judge, and records the run time.

Timer: We use electronic timing, so this is easy. Makes sure the timer has started, or stopped as needed, and give the running time to the scribe to record.

Gate Steward: Helps the Scribe get the sheets in order. Makes sure dogs have been checked in on the gate sheets, and that the dogs are on the line as directed by the judge. Alerts the ring crew and scribe to height changes.

Leash/Score Runner: Picks up the leash and takes it to the ring exit area, brings the scribe sheets to the Trial Secretary.

Ring Crew: Sets bars that are knocked (never during a run, always after the run has been completed), and changes the bars at the jump height change, as directed by the Gate Steward. This job gives you a ring side seat for all the action!

Course Builder: Works with the Chief Course Builder to set the obstacles for the next class.

If you are not comfortable with signing up online to work, there are always plenty of opportunities to do so at the trial.

CPE trial rules – shortened version: see the online rulebook at www.k9cpe.com for registration info, “Registering with CPE” and further info on height categories and rules.

Jump Heights – no dog will jump lower than 4”

P-Card = Permanent Card: the lowest allowable Regular height a dog may jump in CPE.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 15 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries. Registration forms are on the Forms page: www.k9cpe.com. Forms MUST be mailed to CPE and are processed 2-3 times per week. CPE ID numbers are emailed to legible email addresses. Registrations can only be processed from mailed forms.
- Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run and no refund will be issued. Dogs within ½” of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- Only CPE Judges can measure dogs.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Handlers have a choice regarding dogs wearing collars. Dogs may run courses with or without one collar. Collars should preferably be quick release style, and may be flat buckle, rolled leather, or flea prevention. No attachments of any kind are allowed on the collar.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.

- Handlers may not carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, an NT will result. Exception: Handicapped handlers that have a mobility problem in picking up the leash at the finish may put their leash in their pocket – the leash must be out of sight.
- Dogs must be under the handler’s control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.

Training a dog in the ring during a run

There is no training in the ring at a CPE agility trial. First offense will result in an excusal from the run. Further offenses will result in additional excusals for the day/weekend per the judge’s discretion. This is for the safety of the dog. The following items *are not* considered training in the ring (also see FEO):

- Dog grabbing it’s leash at the end of a run (if the run has not yet ended, the dog would receive an NT)
- Asking the dog once for a sit or down on the table in the point games (asking more than once will be a delay of finish, 5 faults/points)

The following items *are* considered training in the ring:

- Violating the 4 paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact)
- Start line stay – leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

While running on course

- The handler will direct the dog through the course without a collar or lead.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10’ feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.

The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5 fault penalty to elimination for any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be, but are not limited to: foul or abusive language, display of anger, extreme frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and/or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE. See Faults, Eliminations and Excusals in the rulebook.

ADDITIONAL NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- * **THERE SHALL BE NO REFUNDS** for entries withdrawn after the closing date, nor in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of reason, or in the event that the test cannot be opened or completed for reasons beyond the control of the organizing committee.
 - * A withdrawal from the test after the closing date due to an injury and/or illness to the dog or handler or for bitches that have come into season after the closing date will be eligible for a credit of \$10 per run entered.
 - * There will be no refunds for incorrect payment for less than \$10.00.
 - * Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of service charges shall be made within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice may result in future entries being declined until paid in full. Any entry shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse by owner/handler.
 - * There will be NO food vendor at this trial.
 - * There will be water available on site.
 - * There will be NO equipment familiarization at this event. A single warm up jump will be provided for competitors.
 - * Dogs must be kept on leash or crated when not working. When walking with your dog, please keep them on a short leash and within eyesight at all times.
 - * PLEASE pick up after your dogs, both at the trial site and at the hotels. Do not allow dogs to pee on buildings or any object that has to be handled!
 - * NO flexi-type leashes in the building. No prong or shock collars on premises.
 - * Catalogs will be e-mailed one week before the trial. Please print and bring your own.
- * This trial is held in an indoor agility facility that is neither heated nor cooled; please dress accordingly.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE – 1841 Horseshoe Pike, Honey Brook, PA 19344

From the East: PA Turnpike Exit 312 (Downingtown) to Route 100 South to Route 113 South, to Route 30 (Bypass) West, to Route 322 West (Horseshoe Pike). Site is on the right approximately 1 mile past Route 82.

From the West: PA Turnpike Exit 298 (Morgantown) to Route 10 South through Morgantown into Honey Brook. Turn left onto Route 322 East (Horseshoe Pike). Trial site will be on the left, a few miles past the town.

From the North: Route 100 South to Route 23 West to Route 345 South to Route 82 South. Turn right at light onto RT 322 (Horseshoe Pike). Proceed approximately 1 mile. Trial site will be on your right across from the tank farm.

From the South: Take Route 202 North to Route 30 West (Bypass) to Route 322 West. Site will be on your right, across from the tank farm, approximately 1 mile past intersection with Route 82.
