* The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.

* It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

* Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms: illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.

DIRECTIONS to Paws 'N Effect, 36 Corporate Ridge, Hamden CT 06514:

I-91: Take Exit 10 (Rt. 40) to end, right onto Rt. 10 (Whitney Ave.), go approx. 1.5 miles, turn left on Sherman Ave. (Dunkin Donuts). Go 0.8 miles, turn right on Corporate Ridge. Building to left a top of hill.

Rt. 15S: Take Exit 62 (Whitney Ave., North), right onto Whitney Ave. Follow as above.

Rt. I-84: Exit onto Rt. 691, first exit onto Rt. 10 South. Through Cheshire into Hamden. Take right onto Sherman Ave. (Dunkin Donuts). Follow as above.

THERE WILL BE NO MEASURING OF DOGS AFTER JUDGE'S BRIEFING BEGINS EACH DAY - ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT CARD MUST BE MEASURED BEFORE THE JUDGES BRIEFING TO SHOW THAT DAY - THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS

PRIZES & AWARDS: Placement rosettes or ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place for Qualifying and non-qualifying scores for all classes. Dogs with an NT (no time) are not eligible for any ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score, and Jr Handlers in Standard.

EXERCISE YOUR DOG RESPONSIBLY! PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG AT THE SHOW SITE AND HOTELS! ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR WARM UP AREA. THERE IS A LEASH LAW IN THE TRIAL SITE'S STATE.

OBSTACLES: The following obstacles may be used. Obstacle specifications shall meet the current CPE obstacle requirements

Aframe – 9' sides, rubber granules, slats	Dog Walk – 12' planks, rubber granules, slats

Attention - COVID-19 Guidelines & Waiver: The COVID-19 waiver included in this premium MUST be signed and sent with your entry, for a valid entry. Masks must be worn by everyone both inside and outside the ring, as well as maintaining at least 6-foot distance both inside and outside the ring. Please be respectful of your fellow exhibitors. If you are entering this trial, be sure you are comfortable with the Covid-19 guidelines and are willing to comply with wearing a mask and social distancing. Exhibitors not complying with these guidelines will be excused from the trial without refund.

Move-Ups: Pre-trial move-ups accepted until noon on Monday March 15. Those who title on Saturday in Standard, Colors or Wildcard MUST complete a move-up form and submit it to the trial secretary by the end of day Saturday. No move-ups for any class will be taken on Sunday.

Briefing and Starting Times: No in-person briefings. A general briefing will be included in your confirmation letter. Course maps (if available) will be emailed to all exhibitors the evening before each day of the trial and will include a judges briefing for each class. A copy of each sheet of course maps will also be posted at the trial. Exhibitors will be responsible for knowing terms and conditions set forth in these briefings. Walk thrus will begin about 7:30 a.m. First dog on the line at 8:00 a.m.

Run Orders: Will be sent electronically to exhibitors on Friday and will be posted.

Check-In: No formal check-in. Gate steward will be at the door directing you as to when to enter the building for walk thrus and will check you in at that time.

Crating: Please plan to work out of your car. There will be a limited number of crating spaces in Little Paws available on a first come first serve basis. Please e-mail the trial secretary at nancy.obara@comcast.net if you want a crating spot.

Parking: If you are crating in Little Paws, please unload and park in the circle or in the lower lot. If you need a Handicapped parking space, please plan to arrive early.

Food: There will be no food or beverages available. Please bring your own.

Refunds: Withdrawals after the closing date due to injury of the dog, or for bitches who come in heat, will be eligible for a partial refund upon receipt of a note from your veterinarian.

Collars: NO prong collars or electronic shock collars of any type are allowed per the show site. Dogs must run "naked." Handlers may place their leash in their pocket or wear them while running the course. If handlers elect to drop their leash as the start, a leash runner will transport the leash to a chair.

Entry Fees: Check your math carefully. Underpayment of fees will not constitute a valid entry. Overpayment of entry fees will not be refunded.

Volunteering: Please consider volunteering. Closer to the trial date, a link to the volunteer schedule will be sent to all exhibitors. You may also sign up at the trial.

CPE trial rules – shortened version: see the online rulebook at www.k9cpe.com for registration info, “Registering with CPE” and further info on height categories and rules.

Jump Heights – no dog will jump lower than 4”

P-Card = Permanent Card: the lowest allowable Regular height a dog may jump in CPE.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 15 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries. Registration forms are on the Forms page: www.k9cpe.com. Forms MUST be mailed to CPE and are processed 2-3 times per week. CPE ID numbers are emailed to legible email addresses. Registrations can only be processed from mailed forms.
- Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run and no refund will be issued. Dogs within ½” of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- Only CPE Judges can measure dogs.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: collars, stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog’s eyes.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.
- Handlers may not carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, an NT will result. Exception: Handicapped handlers that have a mobility

problem in picking up the leash at the finish may put their leash in their pocket – the leash must be out of sight.

- Dogs must be under the handler’s control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.

For clubs that will allow Declared Training In the Ring

We (Host Club) will offer Declared training in the ring. The handler has the option if they want to use a toy or training aid at any time during their run, the handler must approach the Judge during Walkthrough or previously in that trial day for the Judge to approve the toy or training aid for use on the course.

- Handler must alert the Judge upon entry to the ring that the dog will be TIR. Handler is then allowed to have a reasonably sized silent toy/aid with them for use once their run has started (this toy must be approved by the Judge of record PRIOR to the start of the class to determine its eligibility, absolutely no food/scents/audible devices). The toy is NOT allowed to be used in either gate chute or prior to the previous dog leaving the ring.

See the online rulebook or current member letter for additional rules.

The following items *are* considered training in the ring (see Fix and Go):

- Violating the 4 paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact)
- Start line stay – leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

For Clubs that are not allowing Declared Training In the Ring:

We (host club) will not be offering Declared Training in the Ring at this trail. Please remember that the following is not considered Training in the ring:

- Dog grabbing it’s leash at the end of a run (if the run has not yet ended, the dog would receive an NT)
- Asking the dog once for a sit or down on the table in the point games (asking more than once will be a delay of finish, 5 faults/points)

While running on course

- The handler will direct the dog through the course without a collar or lead.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10’ feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.

The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5 fault penalty to elimination for any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be but are not limited to: foul or abusive language, display of anger, extreme frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and / or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE. See Faults, Eliminations and Excusals in the rulebook.
