* It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

* Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms: illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.

THERE WILL BE NO MEASURING OF DOGS AFTER JUDGE'S BRIEFING BEGINS EACH evening - ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT CARD MUST BE MEASURED BEFORE THE JUDGES BRIEFING TO SHOW THAT DAY - THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS

PRIZES & AWARDS: Placement rosettes or ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place for Qualifying and non-qualifying scores for all classes. Dogs with an NT (no time) are not eligible for any ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score, and Jr Handlers in Standard.

EXERCISE YOUR DOG RESPONSIBLY! PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG AT THE SHOW SITE AND HOTELS! ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR WARM UP AREA. THERE IS A LEASH LAW IN THE TRIAL SITE'S STATE.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From Points South/East: Take I-40 West to I-440 (Beltline) to Exit 11 (Route 1 North / Capital Blvd). Continue on Route 1 North/Capital Blvd. until it splits at US-401. Follow US-401 North, which splits to the right. You will go through town of Rolesville and enter Franklin County. Pass Rte 96; turn right on 98 East (the next stoplight). Pass Spencer's Gate development. At first major road, turn right on Bethlehem Church Rd (road called Clifton Pond Rd on other side). Turn left onto Robbins Rd. Look for white fence on left. Turn left into second gravel driveway at Teamworks Dog Training sign.

From I-40 Headed East: Exit I-40 at I-540 West, toward Wake Forest. Continue on I-540 to the Louisburg/401 exit (exit #18). Make a left onto Rte 401 North. Continue on 401 North, going through the town of Rolesville. Pass Rte 96; enter Franklin County. Turn right onto 98 East (will be the next stoplight after crossing Rte 96). Pass Spencer's Gate development. At first major road, turn right on Bethlehem Church Rd (road called Clifton Pond Rd on other side). Turn left onto Robbins Rd. Look for white fence on left. Turn left into second gravel driveway at Teamworks Dog Training sign.

From Virginia and Points North of Raleigh: Take I-95 South to I-85 South. Follow Rte 1 South toward Raleigh. Take Rte 98 East to Wake Forest. Pass Spencer's Gate development. At first major road, turn right on Bethlehem Church Rd (road called Clifton Pond Road on other side). Turn left onto Robbins Rd. Look for the white fence on the left. Turn left into second gravel driveway at Teamworks Dog Training sign.

From Durham and Points West of Raleigh: Take I-85 North. Take US-70 East to Raleigh. Stay in the right hand lane. Watch for small sign for Rte 98 to Wake Forest (it comes up fast). Take Rte 98 East to Wake Forest. You will be on this road for about 40 minutes. Pass Route 50; pass Rte 1. Go through Wake Forest, turning to stay on Rte 98 East. Pass Rte 96. Pass Rte 401. Pass Spencer's Gate development. At first major road, turn right on Bethlehem Church Rd (called Clifton Pond Rd on other side). Turn left onto Robbins Rd Look for white fence on left. Turn left into second gravel driveway at Teamworks Dog Training sign.

"DOGGIE SWIMMING POND"

The swimming pond will be available for trial participants, weather permitting.

The following rules apply at the pond: NO FISHING IN THE POND. NO FEEDING OF BIRDS OR FISH IN THE POND. NO TOSSING FOOD MATTER OF ANY KIND IN THE WATER. NO HUMANS MAY SWIM IN WADE IN, OR DIVE IN THE POND. Any dog using the pond must be current on rabies, Bordetella, and DHPP vaccinations and must not have chronic coughing, any diarrhea, or any vomiting. No dogs in heat allowed in or around the pond. DOGS WITH A FRESH FRONTLINE-TYPE APPLICATION (LESS THAN 48 HOURS) MAY NOT SWIM IN THE POND.

All dog excrement must be removed and disposed of properly in and around the pond. Dogs must remain in the fenced area around the pond to be off leash. Aggressive or unruly dogs or dogs running out of the pond area off leash will be asked to leave. Please allow 2 hours after your dog eats before swimming your dog. There is no guarantee that this pond will be free of snakes or snapping turtles. Please monitor your dog closely and to be safe, keep your dog on a long all-tape Flexi line and have your dog wear a doggie life vest. If you spot a snake or a snapping turtle, please inform Teamworks immediately. There is no guarantee that this pond will remain free of parasites like giardia. If your dog shows signs of sickness inform Teamworks immediately and please see your veterinarian. In cooler weather, please monitor your dog closely for hypothermia; shivering, vomiting or diarrhea and disorientation, dilated pupils, cramps, and a slowed heart rate are all symptoms. People are NOT allowed to swim in the pond, but anyone using the pond assumes all risks associated with swimming and water. There is no life guard on duty. Violators of any of these policies will be asked to leave the site without a refund.

OBSTACLES: The following obstacles may be used. Obstacle specifications shall meet the current CPE obstacle requirements.

Aframe – 9' sides, rubber granules, slats	Dog Walk – 12' planks, rubber granules, slats	
Teeter – 12' plank, rubber granules, slatless	Weave poles – 24" poles - center to center	
Jumps: Bar, Spread, Panel	Open Tunnels	Pause Table – games only

Jump Heights – no dog will jump lower than 4”

P-Card = Permanent Card: the lowest allowable Regular height a dog may jump in CPE.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 15 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries. Registration forms are on the Forms page: www.k9cpe.com. Forms MUST be mailed to CPE and are processed 2-3 times per week. CPE ID numbers are emailed to legible email addresses. Registrations can only be processed from mailed forms.
- Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run and no refund will be issued. Dogs within ½” of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- Only CPE Judges can measure dogs.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- This includes no stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog's eyes.
- Handlers have a choice regarding dogs wearing collars. Dogs may run courses with or without one collar. Collars should preferably be quick release style, and may be flat buckle, rolled leather, or flea prevention. No attachments of any kind are allowed on the collar.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.
- Handlers may carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, the leash must be out of sight or clipped around the waist or shoulders.
- Dogs must be under the handler's control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.

Training a dog in the ring during a run

Teamworks will offer Declared training in the ring. The handler has the option if they want to use a toy or training aid at any time during their run, the handler must approach the Judge during Walkthrough or previously in that trial day for the Judge to approve the toy or training aid for use on the course.

- Handler must alert the Judge upon entry to the ring that the dog will be TIR. Handler is then allowed to have a reasonably sized silent toy/aid with them for use once their run has started (this toy must be approved by the Judge of record PRIOR to the start of the class to determine its eligibility, absolutely no food/scents/audible devices). The toy is NOT allowed to be used in either gate chute or prior to the previous dog leaving the ring.

See the online rulebook or current member letter for additional rules.

The following items are considered training in the ring (see Fix and Go):

- Violating the 4 paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact)
- Start line stay – leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

While running on course

- The handler will direct the dog through the course without a collar or lead.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10' feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.

The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5 fault penalty to elimination for any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be, but are not limited to: foul or abusive language, display of anger, extreme frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and / or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE. See Faults, Eliminations and Excusals in the rulebook.
