Entry Method – Postmark Date

Opening Date: Tuesday, February 11, 2020

- Entries may not be postmarked before the postmark date above
- Entries received before the postmark date will be destroyed
- No entries can be accepted without a legible postmark date.
- All envelopes will be held for 7 days to allow for mail delivery. In the event that the trial limit is exceeded during the 7 days, entries will then be processed in postmark date order. A random draw will then be done from the entries for the postmark date when the limit will be reached.
- If entries received during the postmark 7 day period exceeds the trial's limit, a draw will be held on February 21, 2020 in Cheshire MA .
- Contact the trial secretary by February 20th if you wish to attend the draw.
- Overnight envelopes must have the recipient's signature waiver signed or the envelope may be refused or delayed

THERE WILL BE NO MEASURING OF DOGS AFTER JUDGE'S BRIEFING BEGINS EACH DAY – ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT CARD MUST BE MEASURED BEFORE THE JUDGE'S BRIEFING TO SHOW THAT DAY – THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

Any trained, healthy dog 15 months or older may compete in a CPE agility trial. All purebred and mixed-breeds are equally eligible for entry. Bitches in season or any dogs who are blind, lame or aggressive towards people or other animals are not eligible to compete.

EFFECTIVE FOR ANY TRIAL HELD AFTER 01/01/03:

All dogs entered in a CPE agility trial MUST be registered with CPE prior to the host club's trial closing date.

OBSTACLES: Obstacle specifications shall meet the current CPE obstacle requirements

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Placement rosettes or ribbons will be awarded for first through fourth place for Qualifying and non-qualifying scores for all classes. Dogs with an NT (no time) are not eligible for any ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score, and Jr Handlers in Standard.

RETIRED AGILITY DOG RUN!!!!

A Retired Agility Dog Run will take place on Sunday right after Level 1 Standard. Bars will be set on the ground and you can run your own course or just do a few obstacles, whatever is best for your dog. NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- ✓ The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- ✓ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. A refund of all but \$5 will be given for bitches in season. A letter from your veterinarian is required.
- ✓ It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- ✓ No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- ✓ Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms: illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.
- ✓ Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.
- ✓ There is a returned check fee of \$25.

SOME HOTEL COURTESIES TO OBSERVE

There are very few motels in the area that accommodate competitors and their dogs. Please use care with your dogs in these motels.

Cover the motel's bedding with a sheet, whether or not you think your dog will get on the bed.

Make every effort to have your dog free of fleas BEFORE arriving

Of course, as is standard agility procedure, the dog's handler/owner will pick up all poop. Please bag and dispose of it properly. Remember that your motel is an extension of the show site. You must clean up after your dog.

Don't leave your dog(s) unattended. If you must leave, either take them with you or leave them crated. Even the best dogs(s) can get carried away having fun in a motel room without you present. We WILL request reports from the motels as to the behavior of agility guest and their dogs. Please be respectful of your motel neighbor

NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT AT THE SHOW SITE OVERNIGHT

DIRECTIONS TO TEST SITE

From the North:

Take 91 south to Exit 28 (Bernardston exit, first exit in Mass.) Take a right off the exit ramp and go 0.5 miles. You will be at a "T" with a pizza shop in front of you. Take 5&10 south. Travel 3 miles and right after you enter GREENFIELD driveway is located on Left.

From the South:

Take 91 North to Exit 27 (Route 2 East-Boston). Exit and stay to the right as you will be exiting off Route 2 taking the first Exit (1/10 of a mile) - (Greenfield/Bernardston sign). At the end of this ramp, make a left towards Bernardston (Route 5&10 North). Travel 4 miles. Road to Indoor Action is on your right. (Right after RV SHOP)

From the East:

Take the Mass Pike West to Exit 4 (91 North). Then follow the directions from #1 OR Take Route 2 West to the last exit before 91 North/South. Take the Greenfield\Bernardston exit, at the end of the ramp make a right. You will go about 3.5 miles and we are on the right. Right before our Driveway there is an RV Repair Shop (we are immediately after this shop). Our driveway is the last one in Greenfield, if you pass the "Welcome to Bernardston" sign; you have just missed the driveway. Take the right up the driveway and bear right up the hill.

From the West:

Take the Mass Pike East to Exit 4 (91 North) Then Follow the directions from #1 OR Take Route 2 East to the rotary in Greenfield. Get onto 91 North to Exit 27 (Route 2 East-Boston). Then follow the Directions from #1.

IAS information

We are VERY fortunate to have use of Indoor Action Soccer dome in Greenfield, MA, for this trial and want to be sure and *follow* all rules of the facility so we are invited back for more agility trials in the future.

- 1) The facility will not open until 7am each day.
- 2) There is plenty of parking, but please heed any parking directives.
- 3) There are 2 ways to enter – through the lounge which gives access to the building through a revolving door **OR** through the airlock door (garage sized doors) which will be run by an IAS staff person all day. The air lock door is best for carrying in crates, chairs and other gear. You and dog walk through exterior door which is closed before interior door is opened for direct access to dome. This is necessary to keep the building pressurized. Do NOT use any of the emergency exit doors.
- 4) Plenty of crating in the dome – PLEASE BRING a tarp to put under your crate.
- 5) There is no spitting allowed (we will have spitting police), no food and no drinks other than water allowed in the dome. Food and drinks allowed in lounge area.
- 6) An IAS staff person will be on hand ALL DAY to run the air lock entry and exit and to answer any questions about the facility.
- 7) CLEAN UP is a must. You will be dismissed from the site if you do not pick up after your dog.
- 8) Dogs must be leashed at all times when not competing.
- 9) NO SMOKING in the building.

REMEMBER: THE building will NOT be opened until 7am as an IAS staff person needs to do this and will be in attendance at 7am and throughout the day. For more information and photos of Indoor Action Sports:

Jump Heights – no dog will jump lower than 4”

P-Card = Permanent Card: the lowest allowable Regular height a dog may jump in CPE.

GENERAL CPE RULES FOR ENTRIES/SHOW SITE:

- Dogs must be at least 15 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries. Registration forms are on the Forms page: www.k9cpe.com. Forms MUST be mailed to CPE and are processed 2-3 times per week. CPE ID numbers are emailed to legible email addresses. Registrations can only be processed from mailed forms.
- Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run and no refund will be issued. Dogs within ½” of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- Only CPE Judges can measure dogs.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: collars, stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog’s eyes.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.
- Handlers may not carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, an NT will result. Exception: Handicapped handlers that have a mobility

problem in picking up the leash at the finish may put their leash in their pocket – the leash must be out of sight.

- Dogs must be under the handler’s control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.

Training a dog in the ring during a run

We, Hilltown Hounds, will offer Declared training in the ring. The handler has the option if they want to use a toy or training aid at any time during their run, the handler must approach the Judge during Walkthrough or previously in that trial day for the Judge to approve the toy or training aid for use on the course.

- Handler must alert the Judge upon entry to the ring that the dog will be TIR. Handler is then allowed to have a reasonably sized silent toy/aid with them for use once their run has started (this toy must be approved by the Judge of record PRIOR to the start of the class to determine its eligibility, absolutely no food/scents/audible devices). The toy is NOT allowed to be used in either gate chute or prior to the previous dog leaving the ring.

See the online rulebook or current member letter for additional rules.

The following items are considered training in the ring (see Fix and Go):

- Violating the 4 paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact)
- Start line stay – leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

While running on course

- The handler will direct the dog through the course without a collar or lead.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10’ feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.

The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5 fault penalty to elimination for any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be, but are not limited to: foul or abusive language, display of anger, extreme frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and / or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE. See Faults, Eliminations and Excusals in the rulebook.
