Entries are limited to 500 dogs

200 entries will be held for worker entries – this includes the Host Club dedicated workers and volunteer forms received with the entries
An entry count may be posted on the Nationals event listing, until the limit is reached (it may or may not be updated daily), if the random draw is not necessary.

If more than 500 entries are received, a short waiting list will be maintained until closing day

NOTE: ONLY a change of levels will be taken after the closing date April 23, 2008.

Heights and height categories will NOT be changed

No measuring of dogs is done at Nationals / There will be an early check in on Thursday

Check in times will be listed in the confirmation letter and will depend on the number of entries received

CPE is NOT responsible for mail or emails that are NOT received!**

AN ENTRY WILL BE RETURNED FOR THE FOLLOWING

- Entries received prior to Feb 25, 2008 will be destroyed
- Illegible entry (PRINT in block letters)
- Incomplete Entry – ALL information MUST be filled in including the dog's call name and CPE ID number
- If there are more than 6 dog entries in one envelope (see exception for same CPE membership id #on page one)
- Fees are in other than US funds (Canadian exhibitors – US funds by: bank check, postal money order, personal account in US funds – checks cannot be drawn off of a Canadian funds account)
- Insufficient postage (postage due – envelope will be refused)

AN ENTRY WILL BE DELAYED FOR THE FOLLOWING

- Using any other method than Postal Mail - DO NOT use FedEx, UPS or DHL! (Send Postal overnights to CPE's PO Box address ONLY). The signature waiver on the PO overnight envelope *MUST* be signed or the entry will be delayed.

NOTE: PO Box regular mail is available at 9:30am, overnights after 10am, after 3pm for afternoon overnights

Plan on your check being deposited on March 13, 2008 – there is a \$25 fee for any returned check

Exception if ENTERING MULTIPLE DOGS

- You may send a separate check (up to three checks total) for each additional dog entered.
- Each check MUST be for the full entry amount for at least one dog.

The first check for each multiple entry exhibitor will be deposited when received on or after March 13.

The second check will be deposited April 1; any remaining checks will be deposited May 1.

ACCEPTED ENTRIES

- Entries will be accepted to be included in the random draw, February 25 through March 9, 2008, for dogs who have already completed the requirements stated in "dogs eligible to enter" (see the following premium pages), as of February 24, 2008.
- If the limits have not been reached with the random draw, entries for dog(s) who have OR have not completed the above requirements will be counted towards the limit until the April 23, 2008 closing date - or when the limit has been met. Dogs must have at least completed level 1 if they began showing in CPE at level 1 at their first show.

Move ups are due by May 13, 2008, 11pm ET - NO move ups will be accepted after this date!

There are no move ups at the Nationals due to trophy awards. Move ups must be made by mail (include a sas postcard) OR by email - cpe@charter.net. All move up emails *WILL BE* responded to with a received reply – make sure you get a reply – most are done within 3 days, unless it is a trial weekend.

Check your Nationals confirmation letter carefully

Changes/corrections will NOT be made at the Nationals regardless of who made the error!

CPE is not responsible for lost mail or emails that were not delivered. All emails *received* will be replied to. Make sure all entry info and move ups are correct. Contact CPE if you do not receive a confirmation – two are sent: after the random draw is done; another one before the closing date. A move up confirmation is sent each time a move up is received and processed.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Requirements must be completed before/by February 24, 2008 to send in an entry for the random draw

- If the dog FIRST BEGAN showing in CPE at Level 1 (any height category), all Level 1 titles within that original height category, must have been completed, with a total of at least 15 legs – which includes the level 1 legs.
 - Any other dog must have at least 15 legs total in any combination of height categories, levels and classes
- NOTE: Any entry received for a dog that has not yet obtained the requirements will be held as pending – this also pertains to any dog that is included as a multiple dog entry for the same owner. When the dog has earned the required legs, that entry will be accepted and put into the random draw if before March 9, or entered and counted - *IF the limit of 500 dogs has not yet been met, otherwise, it will be added to the waiting list.*

Each dog must be entered in the level it is currently at in that respective class. A dog cannot be entered in a higher level if it has not finished the previous level requirements for that individual class. A dog does not need to move up to the next level when the current level requirements have been met for the respective class.

Exception: Level C dogs may enter Level 5 if working towards multiple C-ATCH or the Class Champion titles.

All classes must be entered at this event – dogs do not have to run all nine classes

Levels 2 through 5, and "C" will be offered at this trial,

Jr's will earn Jr handler legs in regular Standard for qualifying scores

NOTE: Lower level dogs will be running the same course as the upper level dogs for ALL classes!!!

Courses will be of Nationals level 45C design

Please keep this in mind when entering lower level dogs

Show site information Rings 1 & 2 – Standard, outdoors on dirt, will have snow fencing surrounding each perimeter Rings 3 & 4 – Games, indoors on dirt, will have horizontal metal pole perimeters and snow fencing between the rings Limited shade for outdoor crating, indoor crating cubbies will be available for a fee – see website for forms: www.CPENationals2008.com Lots of room to walk dogs in the fairgrounds on leash Raynor Park west of the fairgrounds is off limits to dogs! Anyone caught in the park with a dog, will be excused from the event without a warning!!! No dogs off leash except in the warm up areas and rings. NO SMOKING is allowed in ANY fairgrounds building! All exhibitors are expected to pick up after their dogs and deposit it in the provided trash barrels, or you will be excused from the event.	

TROPHIES AND AWARDS

Standard Trophies: will be awarded for the High in Standard Classes & High Reserve in Standard classes in each height category in each jump height in each level.

Games Trophies: will be awarded for each height category in each jump height in the 6 Games combined during the event. At least 3 and up to 5 trophies per height category in each jump height will be awarded depending on the number of entries in that height category and jump height.

Rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each height category (Regular and Veterans placements are combined per CPE placement rules), jump height & level in each class.

Qualifying rosettes will be awarded to each dog earning a Qualifying score in any class

Other awards – will receive a rosette and plaque:

High in Trial
 High Veteran
 High Enthusiast
 High Specialist
 High Jr Handler

Each dog that earns a perfect 200 score (all 9 classes earned a qualifying run with zero faults), will receive a plaque direct shipped by CPE after the event

THIS AGILITY TRIAL WILL BE JUDGED UNDER THE CURRENT RULES AND REGULATIONS OF CPE
The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles under the current rule of CPE.
Any trained, healthy dog 15 months or older may compete in a CPE agility trail. All purebred and mixed-breeds are equally eligible for entry. Bitches in season or any dogs who are blind, lame or aggressive towards people or animals are not eligible to compete.
It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, there will be no refund of fees.
Refunds <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ No refund for bitches in season.➤ Dogs that are injured after the closing date will be eligible for a refund of 50% of the entry fees ONLY when receipt of a vet's letter on their office letterhead, is received by CPE. Such a letter is due no later than May 23, 2008 at the CPE offices, or by hand, no later than 5pm at the show site on May 29, 2008. Letters received during or after the trial, will not result in a refund. Letters will be verified with your veterinarian's office.➤ In the unfortunate circumstance of losing a beloved dog that is entered in the trial, a full refund of fees will be forthcoming even if after the closing date.➤ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog or handler is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee or a judge.➤ No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergence, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
Returned check fee - \$25.
All dogs must be on leash at all times except when using the warm up area, or in the agility ring.
Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show. Such entries will be returned to the handler.
Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up area consisting of a regulation jump shall be provided for all entered dogs.
Collars are not allowed when a dog is running the course. NO attachments of any kind are allowed to be on the leash. A regular collar/leash, quick off/on harness/leash, slip lead, martingale slip lead - are allowed to use to take the dog in/out of the ring. Pinch collars are allowed on the site, however, cannot be used to take the dog in/out of the ring. Dogs must be under the handlers control when leaving the ring.
A dog will not be penalized if they pick up their leash when their run is completed. A dog will be assigned a NT (No Time) for an NQ if the dog picks up the leash before the run has been completed.
Food, toys and training devices are not allowed on the course or within 10' of the ring. Do NOT tug with your dog within 10' of the ring or in close proximity of people or other dogs.
The standard rings for this event will be held outside on dirt regardless of weather. If there is an unseasonable amount of rain to determine that the outdoor dirt rings would be unsafe, the rings will then be moved to the farther grass area.
No puppies under 8 weeks old are allowed at a CPE trial. Selling of puppies at the show site is not allowed.
