

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

* The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.

* It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

* No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

* Fees will be refunded if the trial is cancelled due to Covid-19.

* Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms: illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.

* Sault Ste. Marie KOA Holiday COVID Policy stipulates that no visitors are permitted in the campground. People on site must either be registered campers, or agility trial participants/volunteers.

Accommodations:

Camping is available on site at the Sault Ste. Marie KOA Holiday. Participants wishing to stay on site will receive a 10% discount on all accommodations. Please make your reservations on line at www.koassm.com under "Campground Hot Deals", or call 705-759-2344 to make your reservations, and ask for the "Dog Sports Discount". Pets are welcome in the Camping Cabins, but unfortunately are not permitted in the Deluxe Cabins. Not valid with any other discounts.

Directions:

Approximately 5 miles north of downtown Sault Ste. Marie. West on Fifth Line. East off Highway 17N. Campground is approximately ¼ mile in from the highway, on your left. Note: If following GPS, please turn west on Fifth Line, NOT east as GPS may indicate. Some GPS may not accept "Fifth Line", try "5 Line". GPS coordinates N46.57938 W84.328977.

From the USA: When leaving Customs at bridge from USA, turn right just out of Customs booth through the gate on the right onto Queen Street and go under the bridge you just came over. Follow signs for 17N truck route to Fifth Line East, per above.

From the East: If arriving from the east (Sudbury), follow signs for 17 north and west to Thunder Bay. This will direct you on a bypass around downtown, following Black Road, Second Line and 17N. Continue to Fifth Line East, per above.

From the North/West: If arriving from Thunder Bay, you will see a sign welcoming you to Sault Ste. Marie. A short distance after the sign, turn right on Fifth Line East.

THERE WILL BE NO MEASURING OF DOGS AFTER JUDGE'S BRIEFING BEGINS EACH DAY. ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT CARD MUST BE MEASURED BEFORE THE JUDGE'S BRIEFING TO SHOW THAT DAY. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS!

PRIZES & AWARDS: Placement rosettes or ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place for qualifying and non-qualifying scores for all classes. Dogs with an NT (no time) are not eligible for any ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score, and Jr Handlers in Standard.

EXERCISE YOUR DOG RESPONSIBLY!

PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG AT THE SHOW SITE AND CAMPGROUND. ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR WARM UP AREA.

Jump Heights – no dog will jump lower than 4”

P-Card = Permanent Card: the lowest allowable Regular height a dog may jump in CPE.

General CPE rules for entries/show site

- Dogs must be at least 15 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries. Registration forms are on the Forms page: www.k9cpe.com. Forms MUST be mailed to CPE and are processed 2-3 times per week. CPE ID numbers are emailed to legible email addresses. Registrations can only be processed from mailed forms.
- Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run and no refund will be issued. Dogs within ½” of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- Only CPE Judges can measure dogs.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog’s eyes.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.
- All handlers have the choice to put their leash in their pocket or safely loop it around their waist or neck. It does not have to be out of the dog’s sight, however, if the dog plays with it during the run, it would be considered a toy. If the handler cannot carry their leash, leashes will be dropped on the ground at the start line and retrieve it after their run. Do not loop leashes on the ring barrier.
- Dogs must be under the handler’s control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.

For clubs that will allow Declared Training In the Ring

We (Host Club) will offer Declared training in the ring. The handler has the option if they want to use a toy or training aid at any time during their run, the handler must approach the Judge during Walkthrough or previously in that trial day for the Judge to approve the toy or training aid for use on the course.

- Handler must alert the Judge upon entry to the ring that the dog will be TIR. Handler is then allowed to have a reasonably sized silent toy/aid with them for use once their run has started (this toy must be approved by the Judge of record PRIOR to the start of the class to determine its eligibility, absolutely no food/scents/audible devices). The toy is NOT allowed to be used in either gate chute or prior to the previous dog leaving the ring.

See the online rulebook or current member letter for additional rules.

The following items are considered training in the ring (see Fix and Go):

- Violating the 4 paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact)
- Start line stay – leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

For Clubs that are not allowing Declared Training In the Ring

We (host club) will not be offering Declared Training in the Ring at this trail. Please remember that the following is not considered Training in the ring:

- Dog grabbing it’s leash at the end of a run (if the run has not yet ended, the dog would receive an NT)
- Asking the dog once for a sit or down on the table in the point games (asking more than once will be a delay of finish, 5 faults/points)

While running on course

- The handler will direct the dog through the course without a collar or lead.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10’ feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.

The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5 fault penalty to elimination for any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be but are not limited to: foul or abusive language, display of anger, extreme frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and / or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE. See Faults, Eliminations and Excusals in the rulebook.

ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

- Specific precautions will be emailed to each competitor the week prior to the trial, with the latest local, provincial and federal guidelines.
- If you are ill, PLEASE STAY HOME. If the Club deems an exhibitor ill at the event, you will be excused with no refund.
- Make sure your dog is okay with people wearing masks. We don't want a dog becoming fearful due to something they've never seen before.
- Please bring your own soap and towel. There is a sink and hot/cold water not far from the ring.
- Please bring your own gloves if you choose to wear them. Please dispose of them properly.
- Please bring your own food and beverages. None will be provided.
- Make sure you are entering your dog in the correct jump height per the jump height table in the CPE rulebook.
- Crating should be done from your car, or bring a shade tent or screen if you will be crating outside your car. Please maintain AT LEAST 6 feet between yourself and the next set up.
- Course maps will be mailed in pdf format to you the evening before each trial day, usually by 7 pm. Full size courses will be posted at the site as well.
- Judge's class briefings will be listed on each course map. The judge will need to specify a location at the site to answer questions during each walk thru, keeping physical distancing in mind.
- There will be no check in as usual. The gate steward shall call out during the walk thru to check in dogs. Gate stewards will have their own pen/marker.
- Course builders are to wash their hands before and after working.
- Walk thrus will be split for any class over the local specifics on physical distancing and group size. This will be determined by the Club and the Judge. Any splits should be listed in the general briefing email if possible. When walk thrus are split, time will be reduced to 5 minutes, walk each group and then run each group (ie. Walk, walk, run, run). This will save time and keep groups moving yet allow for physical distancing rules.
- At the gate before a run, it will be the exhibitor's responsibility to physical distance and be ready to run when it is your turn. After your run, please leave the ring area as soon as possible.
- Please take pictures of results and then move on. Results will be posted, not in a book.
