

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Note: If necessary, you will receive additional information in the final confirmation email about tweaks to our usual trial processes due to any current COVID-19 restrictions which will be based on Humboldt County's regulations.

* The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.

* It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

* Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms: illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.

* **SET-UP and CHECK-IN:** Exhibitors can enter the grounds for set-up at 12:00 PM Friday. Check-in on Friday will be at 2:00 PM; Walk-through will start at 2:30PM; First dog on the line at 3:00 PM. Saturday & Sunday check-in will be at 7:00 AM; Walk-through will start at 7:30 AM; First dog on the line at 8:00 AM

* **DRAWING:** We are planning a great drawing. Come prepared to buy lots of tickets.

* **FOOD:** There will be no food vendor on the grounds. Further information will be provided in the final trial notes.

* **VENDORS:** There will be no vendors on the grounds.

* **SITE INFORMATION:** The trial will be run outdoors on grass running surface. There will be two (2) rings, however only one ring will be running at a time. There is ample water on site but shade is in short supply, so bring your canopy. August is frequently cool and breezy. We wish to be welcomed back, so PLEASE... pick up after your dog... Keep your dog on leash when not competing... No Smoking on the grounds... Keep your dogs and children under control.

The following order is the scheduled order for the trial to be run. Two rings will be used, and the judge will rotate between rings. If the order needs to be changed for the trial due to extreme pre-trial circumstances, it will be posted in the confirmation letter sent to exhibitors at least 7 days before the first trial day. The order will only be changed at the trial in the case of an extreme reason and must be agreed upon by the host club and judge.

Briefing information from the judge and the club will be sent via email with the final trial notes.

PRIZES & AWARDS: Placement rosettes or ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place for Qualifying and non-qualifying scores for all classes. Dogs with an NT (no time) are not eligible for any ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score, and Jr Handlers in Standard.

EXERCISE YOUR DOG RESPONSIBLY! PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG AT THE SHOW SITE AND HOTELS! ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR WARM UP AREA. FLAGGED AREAS ARE OFF LIMITS TO EXHIBITORS.

OBSTACLES: Obstacle specifications shall meet the current CPE obstacle requirements. See CPE rulebook for updated list.

Workers Needed and Appreciated

Your help is needed to hold a successful trial. We are asking all entrants to help with *just one thing* each day (of course, we'll definitely let you do more if you want to). The types of jobs are listed below. Don't worry if you don't know how to do a job! They are easy and we can show you how!

Every worker will receive a \$1.00 voucher for Workers only drawing or for next year's trial.

To sign up for a job, just locate the white boards towards the front of the rings and write your name in where you would like to work. **Please sign up as soon as you can and arrive at the appropriate ring when the class starts**, as it allows us to keep the trial moving along.

Course Builder	Helps the Chief Course Builders build the courses.
Gate Steward	Makes sure all dogs are ready at the start line.
Leash Runner	Takes leash from the start line to the finish line.
Pole Setter	Adjusts jump heights, resets jump bars and other equipment, as needed.
Runner	Takes scribe sheets from the scribe to the score table.
Scribe	Watches judge and marks all faults and enters time from Timer for each dog.
Timer	Uses stopwatch / timer to time each dog.
Sunday Clean-up	Ring teardown, Equipment moving, etc. This starts as the last class is completed.

CPE trial rules – shortened version: see the online rulebook at www.k9cpe.com for registration info, “CPE Membership Information” and further info on height categories and rules.

Jump Heights – no dog will jump lower than 4”

P-Card = Permanent Card: the lowest allowable Regular height a dog may jump in CPE.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 15 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial. To register your dog, go to the CPE Member Services page at <https://www.k9cpe.com/memberservices>.
- Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run and no refund will be issued. Dogs within ½" of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- Only CPE Judges can measure dogs.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs can now run with or without a collar. Collars should preferably be a quick release style, a flat buckle, rolled leather or flea prevention. No attachments of any kind are allowed on the collar.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may not be used to take a dog into the ring.
- Handlers may carry their leash with them on the course – if done so the leash must be out of sight or clipped around the shoulders or waist.
- Dogs must be under the handler's control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.

While running on course

- The handler will direct the dog through the course without a lead.
- Food, (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10' feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- Toys, training devices are not allowed within 10' of the ring except as part of Declared Training in the Ring described below.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exception noted below under prior to class starting.
Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.

The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5-fault penalty to elimination for any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be but are not limited to: foul or abusive language, display of anger, frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and / or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE. See Faults, Eliminations and Excusals.

Training a dog in the ring during a run

HumDOG will offer Declared Training In the Ring. The handler has the option if they want to use a toy or training aid at any time during their run. The handler must approach the judge during walk-through or previously in that trial day for the Judge to approve the toy or training aid for use on the course:

- Handler must alert the Judge upon entry to the ring that the dog will be TIR. Handler is then allowed to have a reasonably sized, silent toy/aid with them for use once their run has started (toy must be approved by the Judge of record PRIOR to the start of the class to determine eligibility – absolutely no food/scents/audible devices.)
- Approved toy is NOT allowed to be used in either gate chute or prior to the previous dog leaving the ring.

See the online rulebook for additional rules.

The following items *are* considered training in the ring (See Fix and Go):

- Violating the 4 paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact)
- Start line stay – leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

No changes to trial results will be made once the trial has been completed – handlers are responsible for the accuracy of information in their confirmation from the trial secretary (dog's info, level, height category and/or jump height, etc), prior to running in a trial, and for reporting any discrepancies of posted results prior to leaving the trial site each day. This also includes if there was a correction to a scribe sheet – the handler must verify that the results were corrected as well.

Car Parking

Exhibitors can enter the grounds to begin set-up at **12:00 PM Friday**. For **Friday set-up**, turn right at the school and drive approximately 275 feet to the parking area.
