\* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.

\* It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

\* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

\* Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms: illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 15 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries. Registration forms are on the Forms page: [www.k9cpe.com](http://www.k9cpe.com). Forms MUST be mailed to CPE and are processed 2-3 times per week. CPE ID numbers are emailed to legible email addresses. Registrations can only be processed from mailed forms.
- Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run and no refund will be issued. Dogs within ½” of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- Only CPE Judges can measure dogs.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

#### **Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring**

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: collars, stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog’s eyes.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.
- Handlers may not carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, an NT will result. Exception: Handicapped handlers that have a mobility problem in picking up the leash at the finish may put their leash in their pocket – the leash must be out of sight.
- Dogs must be under the handler’s control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.

#### **For clubs that will allow Declared Training In the Ring**

We (Host Club) will offer Declared training in the ring. The handler has the option if they want to use a toy or training aid at any time during their run, the handler must approach the Judge during Walkthrough or previously in that trial day for the Judge to approve the toy or training aid for use on the course.

- Handler must alert the Judge upon entry to the ring that the dog will be TIR. Handler is then allowed to have a reasonably sized silent toy/aid with them for use once their run has started (this toy must be approved by the Judge of record PRIOR to the start of the class to determine its eligibility, absolutely no food/scents/audible devices). The toy is NOT allowed to be used in either gate chute or prior to the previous dog leaving the ring.

See the online rulebook or current member letter for additional rules.

The following items *are* considered training in the ring (see Fix and Go):

- Violating the 4 paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact)
- Start line stay – leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

#### **For Clubs that are not allowing Declared Training In the Ring:**

We (host club) will not be offering Declared Training in the Ring at this trail. Please remember that the following is not considered Training in the ring:

- Dog grabbing it’s leash at the end of a run (if the run has not yet ended, the dog would receive an NT)
- Asking the dog once for a sit or down on the table in the point games (asking more than once will be a delay of finish, 5 faults/points)

#### **While running on course**

- The handler will direct the dog through the course without a collar or lead.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10’ feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.

The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5 fault penalty to elimination for any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be but are not limited to: foul or abusive language, display of anger, extreme frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and / or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE. See Faults, Eliminations and Excusals in the rulebook.

# August CPE Agility Trial

Thank you for working with us to keep dogs and people safe while we conduct an agility trial in these unusual circumstances. We want you to be aware of what we are planning and make sure you come to the trial with an understanding of our plans and expectations of exhibitors. We plan on adhering to CDC, local government, facility and CPE guidelines. As those guidelines are updated, we may have to modify these expectations. We will notify you prior to the date of the trial if the agility committee determines more or less stringent measures are needed. Withdrawals after the closing date will be refunded minus any CPE fees. Do not compete if you feel ill or have been exposed to someone who has symptoms of COVID-19. If you feel ill on the day of trial, please stay home. We will refund your entry fees minus the minimal CPE fees. If you choose to enter you should be aware of the following:

## Building Restrictions

- There will be no spectators in the building, just you, your dog(s), crate(s) and your stuff.
- Building occupancy will be limited. All unentered dogs and visitors must remain outside. Everyone is welcome to crate outside. We will reserve parking spaces closest to the building for those choosing to crate in their car. We ask those of you who are crating inside to park in the unreserved spaces.
- Crating spaces will be small, room for a chair and 2 medium sized crates. Competitors' crate(s), chair and any personal items must remain within assigned taped off space. You must sit inside the designate crating space with your dog, crate and stuff. There will be a few larger spaces for those with large or many dogs. Please be considerate and leave these spaces for those with multiple larger dogs.
- We may designate separate entrance and exit doors so please watch for signage.
- No food service will be available. Please bring your own food and beverages.
- We also ask those crating in their cars to not share food or gather in large groups without social distancing or masks.
- There will be a gate steward. Please observe social distancing while waiting, entering and exiting the ring.
- Course maps will be emailed beforehand.

## Masks

- Mask wearing will be required in the building. Wearing a mask means covering your mouth and nose **completely** at all times. We will have a limited number of masks available. Wearing a mask while running will be **required**.
- Ring crew will be wearing a masks

## Safety and Sanitation

- We will have hand sanitizer available and hand soap in bathroom

## Changes to normal trial practices

- No copies of course maps will be made. You can access courses through your email or photograph these with your phone. The maps will be posted in a variety of spots around the building. Please use social distancing when looking at or photographing these maps.
- The running order will also be emailed in advance.
- During runs, leashes may be placed in pocket if leash can fully fit in pocket. We will also have a leach runner/bar setter who will use a pickup stick and place these on a chair that will be sanitized frequently.
- As necessary to comply with occupancy limits, walk throughs will be divided.
- Social distancing will be observed when lining up to enter the ring and throughout the trial.
- Social distancing will be in place for check in, ribbon distribution, posting of results and other trial practices.
- Ribbons will be available for pick up from the door to the storage room in the interior hallway. Please observe social distancing when picking up your ribbon

## Outside of the Building

We encourage you to wear a mask and maintain social distancing while outside.
