Measuring of Dogs at CPE trials after Oct 1, 2020

It has been determined that CPE will return to measuring of dogs entered in CPE trials effective for trials held after Oct1, 2020. This will include new dogs who do not yet have an official measurement with CPE as well as dogs who require a second measurement because of their turning 2 years old during our recent pause on measuring during CoVid.

The measuring area will be considered part of the ring and therefore will require the Judge, handler and any other exhibitor within 6' of the measuring area to be wearing a mask.

Judges are permitted to bring their own set of measuring wickets to sites that currently use a defined measurement style measuring device if they so choose to help speed the measuring process. All measuring devices must be calibrated by the Judge prior to each day to confirm measurements.

To avoid everyone having to arrive at the start of the show each day, Judges will be allowed to measure throughout the day prior to the particular dogs first run of the trial. If there is a second Judge at the trial, the Judge of record can appoint this Judge to do measuring for the trial if the second Judge agrees to step in. In this case both Judges must sign the measuring sheet. Judges must also make sure that they indicate the type of measuring device used when completing the measuring sheet.
