Trial Hours: 7 am until one hour after judging is completed. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. E-mail confirmations will be sent to those listing a legible e-mail address on the entry form.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry – a \$25 collection fee will be added to the amount of each returned check.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crate set up prior to the trial date is only available to volunteers who assist in trial set up at the designated time at approximately 1:30 pm on Friday, December 16.
Indoor crating for competitors and volunteers is available in the agility building. A waterproof floor cover is required to place beneath your crate.

NO SMOKING inside or within 30 feet of the building.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Queen City Agility Club and/or Queen City Dog Training Club and their agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Queen City Agility Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against Queen City Agility Club and/or Queen City Dog Training Club or any official.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. As such, the club will refund the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial. Injured dogs will receive a refund of entry fee minus \$9/day if a signed veterinary certificate is presented to the trial secretary prior to the first dog run on the first day.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.
