Search areas will be in barns and outside areas.
One dog per handler per class per level
4 judges TBD
Limited to 150 dogs per judge per section of classes
There will be 2 sections of classes per day.
Each section will include:
2 Rounds of Containers
1 Round of Interior
1 Round of Exterior
1 Round of Vehicles

Entry Method is Random Draw

Random Draw mail in entry dates will be two weeks in duration and will be listed in the premium when posted in December 2021 or earlier
See the premium when posted for the actual draw date (if needed) and detailed info or emails asking about the premium before it is posted will not be answered

Note: if multiple entries are received for the same dog, all entries for that dog/owner will be destroyed prior to the random draw

See the premium when posted for emailed confirmation notification dates

**Closing date: April 6, 2022 – no refunds after this date for pulled dogs
no height category changes after closing date**

Move up/down level date will be listed in the premium – no level changes after the closing date.

Levels 2, 3, 5 and C will be offered

Note: regular rules apply - current Level C dogs may enter Level 5

There will be a High In Trail Award for each level offered.

To be eligible for this award, you must enter the highest level that you have earned Q's in for all runs. See below for eligibility requirements.

- To be eligible for the High In Trial Award, the dog must be entered in all runs at the same level.
- The dog must be entered in the highest level that they have earned a Q in. Exception is level C and enter level 5.
- If all classes are not at the same level, the dog would move back to the lower level after this event to complete any level requirements. All Q's will remain in the level in which they were earned.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER 2022 CSS CPE NATIONALS

Entries will be accepted to be included in the random draw, for dogs that have completed eligibility per below

Note: make sure your dog is not missing ANY lower level legs that are required for entry or your dog will not be eligible to send an entry for the random draw. This can include a CCSS-LCH/CCSS-LEX dog that is missing a lower level leg. CPE is NOT responsible for dogs that were moved up in error, regardless of upper level titles earned. See your online member records to verify your progress.

- To enter – a dog must have completed level 1 and earned at least 12 legs between January 1, 2021 and December 31, 2021.
- The 12 legs can be earned at any level as long as the dog meets level eligibility criteria listed below.

CSS eligibility criteria

- A dog must complete all level 1 requirements and earn 12 additional legs.
- All Q's earned at this event will count for the respective titles per the level earned.

If you are planning on entering both CSS and agility at the national event including agility run thrus on Thursday, the CSS event will take precedence and we will work through any conflicts with agility run thrus.
