

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

* The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.

* It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

* Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms: illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.



DIRECTIONS TO THE SITE

From Route 95 Exit 48 to Larrabee Rd., .5 miles take a right on to Riverside St., .4 miles take a right on to Warren Ave., 1.4 miles take a right on to Bishop St. The Happy Tails Complex will be on your left. Parking is in front of the training center entrance, on the street, and in the Community Center Parking lot across the street. Please do not park from the daycare entrance to the dumpsters.

The training center entrance is the red door with the training center sign on it. Located to the right of the only set of outside stairs. Please do not enter through the daycare class doors. Look for the SpeedWay Trial sign.

- There will be crating inside. Competitors are also welcome to crate out of their vehicles. Please only bring dogs entered in the trial with you.
- Additional Pandemic Precautions: Please ensure that you review CPE's guidelines regarding the pandemic PRIOR to entering the trial. We WILL be following the most up to date guidelines put out by CPE. We will also be following all state guidelines and requirements related to mask-wearing and crowds gathering.
- Please follow signs for designated parking areas.
- Snacks and water will be available for workers during the trial.
- No food allowed within 10 feet of the ring.

CPE general SpeedWay trial rules: see the online rulebook at www.k9cpe.com for further info on divisions and complete details.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 12 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class.
- No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: collars, stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog's eyes. **Exception – a flat collar with nothing attached, is allowed to facilitate the catching of the dog at the end of the run.**
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.
- Handlers may carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, the leash must be in a pocket, out of sight of the dog.
- Dogs must be under the handler's control when leaving the ring
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10' feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.
- The handler may use the verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course.
