

Notice to Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this event, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the event committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee.
- Exhibitors are responsible for the complete, accurate and legible information on the entry forms. Illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.

Limits: Trial is limited to 400 runs . Dogs are limited to 12 runs . Training in the Ring is allowed.
Day of Show Entries: This trial will accept day of show entries however there is no guarantee there will be runs available.

Prizes and Awards: Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs with No Time are not eligible for ribbons.

Exercise your dog responsibly! Pick up after your dog at the show site and the hotels. All dogs must be on a leash except when in the ring. There is a leash law in Nebraska.

VOLUNTEERS: Trials run smoother with your help!

Please sign up to work. A worker sign-up form will be at the trial. Don't worry if you don't know how to do a job! They are easy and we can show you how!

CRATING: There is limited crating space available indoors on hard surface floor in the Animal Science Atrium. Please use mats. You can crate out of your vehicle if desired. Parking is convenient to the arena entrance. No ex-pens. We anticipate being done in 4-5 hours.

PANDEMIC: Please ensure that you review CPE's guidelines regarding the pandemic PRIOR to entering the trial. We will be following the most up-to-date guidelines put out by CPE. We will also be following all state guidelines and requirements related to mask-wearing and crowds gathering.

CPE general SpeedWay trial rules: see the online rulebook at www.k9cpe.com for further info on divisions and complete details.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 12 months or older the first day of the trial.
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class.
- No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may not be used to take a dog into the ring. (Note: Prong Collars not allowed at this site.)
- Handlers may carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, the leash must be in a pocket, out of sight of the dog.
- Dogs must be under the handler's control when leaving the ring.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10' feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.
- The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course.
