

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

* The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.

* It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

* Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms: illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.

Some GPS's try to bring you off Sparta pike to Beech Log - That is very windy back way in and it's easy to get lost. So sometimes it's easier to put in the coordinates - Corner of Beech log Rd and Cainsville Rd N 36 degrees 05.448' W 086 degrees 14.191'

From Nashville

Take I-40 E towards Lebanon Take exit 239a Watertown , stay in right hand land - 3/10 mile turn right at light at stop sign turn left onto 266 Cainesville Pike Rd. go 7 miles to Beach Log Road on Left go approximately 2.3 miles to Never Go Back Ranch (on Left log cabin on top of hill) pass cabin to continue up to barn at top of hill

From Franklin / 840

take exit for Speedway, go right to Murfreesboro Rd at stop sign make left go to 265 Chicken Road go right drive about 6 miles to Cainesville pike rt 265 make right about 1 mile up road make Left on Beech Log Road - follow above

From Murfreesboro

Take 96 Lacassas Pike (East) to Cainesville pike Rt 265 (Left) Go 11 miles to Beech Log Road on Right (you will go thru town of Norcross but if you come to Rt 265 you went too far) - follow above

VOLUNTEERS: Trials run smoother with your help! ☺ Please sign up to work. A worker sign-up form will be at the trial. Don't worry if you don't know how to do a job! They are easy and we can show you how!

CRATING: There is limited crating space available in empty horse stalls, although the majority of competitors crate out of their vehicles. Parking is convenient to the arena entrance. No ex-pens unless they take up less room than a crate would. We anticipate being done in 3-4 hours.

PANDEMIC: Please ensure that you review CPE's guidelines regarding the pandemic PRIOR to entering the trial. We will be following the most up-to-date guidelines put out by CPE. We will also be following all state guidelines and requirements related to mask-wearing and crowds gathering.

REFUNDS: Bitches in season and injured dogs should not compete in agility trials. Refund of entry fees for injured dogs or bitches entered in the trial that come in season after the closing date of this trial may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the trial secretary before the start date of the trial. Entry fees will be refunded less \$5.00 per run. Unfortunately, we are only able to provide these refunds for bitches in season and injured dogs. We are not able to provide refunds due to other reasons for which one must withdraw after the closing date, unless there is a waiting list for the trial.

Please double check the total amount due before writing your check. Any over-payments in the amount of \$10 or less will NOT be refunded.

CPE general SpeedWay trial rules: see the online rulebook at www.k9cpe.com for further info on divisions and complete details.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 12 months or older the first day of the trial.
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class.
- No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.
- Handlers may carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, the leash must be in a pocket, out of sight of the dog.
- Dogs must be under the handler's control when leaving the ring.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10' feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.
- The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course.
