

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

* The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.

* It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

* Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms: illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show. Returned checks will not be considered a valid entry fee, and there will be a \$30.00 charge for returned checks.

Rt 15 south – Take exit 62 (Whitney Ave. north). Right onto Whitney Ave and follow as above.

Rt 15 north – Exit 60 (Dixwell Ave) Left onto Dixwell, then left onto Rt 10 north. Go 2.1 mi to Sherman Ave and follow as above.

Dogs with an NT (no time) are not eligible for any ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score, and Jr Handlers in all classes.

EXERCISE YOUR DOG RESPONSIBLY! PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG AT THE SHOW SITE AND HOTELS! ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR WARM UP AREA. THERE IS A LEASH LAW IN THE TRIAL SITE'S STATE.

CRATING: There will be a limited number of crating spaces in Little Paws available on a first come, first serve basis.

PARKING: If you are crating in Little Paws, please unload and park in the circle or in the lower lot. There will be a committee member there to guide you. If you need a Handicapped parking space, please plan to arrive early.

FOOD: There will be no food or beverage available.

REFUNDS: Withdrawals after the closing date due to injury of the dog, or for bitches who come in heat will be eligible for 75% refund of entry fee paid upon receipt of a note from your veterinarian.

COLLARS: NO prong collars or electronic shock collars of any type are allowed per the show site. Dogs must run "naked." Handlers may place their leash in their pocket or wear them while running the course. If handlers elect to drop their leash as the start, a leash runner will use a gripper device to pick up and transport the leash to a chair or ground.

Worker's Schedule:

An email will be sent 2 weeks prior to the trial asking for workers to sign up online.

ATTENTION!!! COVID -19 Guidelines: Any specific guidelines in regard to COVID-19 will be sent via the confirmation. These will be in line with CDC and the state of CT guidelines in effect at the time of the trial. Rules are subject to change. We are doing our best to make this trial safe. Please respect our efforts.

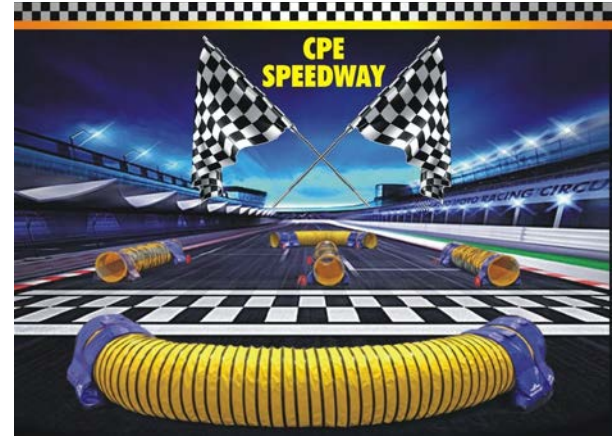
General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 12 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class.
- No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: collars, stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog's eyes. **Exception – Drag Race: a flat collar with nothing attached, is allowed to facilitate the catching of the dog at the end of the run.**
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.
- Handlers may carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, the leash must be in a pocket, out of sight of the dog.
- Dogs must be under the handler's control when leaving the ring
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10' feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.
- The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course.
