- * The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- * Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.
- *REFUNDS:Withdrawals after the closing date due to injury of the dog, or for bitches who come in heat will be eligible for 75% refund of entry fee paid upon receipt of a note from your veterinarian.
- * It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- * No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Job Descriptions

Scribe: The scribe marks the faults or points as directed by the judge. You must be able to pay full attention to the judge and not the dog during a run.

Timer: Electronic timing will be used. Timer tells the team when to “go” and starts/stops the timer or monitors that timer has automatically started/stopped (depending on class).

Gate Steward: Ensures dogs and handlers are ready at the start line and helps the scribe and/or assistant scribe match the running order on the gate steward sheets.

Course Builder: Moves obstacles as directed by the judge and/or chief course builder. This is a great way to learn how to set a course.

Leash Runner: Pick up the leash and place in on a chair in the Gate Chute.

CPE general SpeedWay trial rules: see the online rulebook at www.k9cpe.com for further info on divisions and complete details.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 12 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class.
- No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body, a flat collar with nothing attached, is allowed. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog's eyes.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.
- Handlers may carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, the leash must be in a pocket, out of sight of the dog.
- Dogs must be under the handler's control when leaving the ring
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10' feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.
- The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course.

Site Information

- **5 mph speed limit on the property. Violators will be asked to leave the trial site and no refunds will be issued.**
- **All dogs must be on leash and under control at all times except when using the warm up area or in the ring.**
- **No food, toys, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within ten feet of the ring at any time.**
- **No clickers or squeakers to be used anywhere in the building.**
- No unsupervised children shall be allowed on the premises.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages is not permitted during trial hours.
- No smoking in or within 50 feet of any building.
- You must clean up after your dog and place waste in the receptacles provided. Failure to do so may lead to being excused from the trial.
- Absolutely NO food or treats are to be left in the arena overnight.
- **Crating space will be available in a separate temperature-controlled building near-by. Crating spaces may be limited, working out of your vehicle is encouraged.**
- **DIRECTIONS:**
- *You can use MapQuest or GPS directions for 36 Corporate Ridge, Hamden, Ct 06514*
- From I-91 – Take exit 10 (rt 40) to end. Right onto Rt 10 (Whitney Ave) approx 1 mi. to left onto Sherman Ave at Dunkin Donuts. 8/10 mi to right onto Corporate Ridge. Bldg to left at top of hill
- Rt 15 south – Take exit 62 (Whitney Ave. north). Right onto Whitney Ave and follow as above.
- Rt 15 north – Exit 60 (Dixwell Ave) Left onto Dixwell, then left onto Rt 10 north. Go 2.1 miles onto Sherman Ave and follow as above.
- I-84 – Exit to I-691, first exit onto Rt 10 south. Through Cheshire into Hamden to right onto Sherman Ave and follow as above.

PARKING: Unloading is permitted near the entrance to the crating building. Overnight RV is not permitted at the site, per zoning regulations. Handicapped spaces are available on a first come, first served basis. If you need Handicapped parking, please plan to arrive early.
