

### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- ✿ The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- ✿ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. After closing, a refund of all but \$3/class entered will be given for bitches in season or injured dogs. A letter from your veterinarian is required.
- ✿ \*There is a returned check fee of \$35.
- ✿ It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- ✿ No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- ✿ Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms: illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.

#### **SITE INFORMATION**

**Crating is limited. No ex pens allowed. No practicing in the rings is allowed at any time. ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA. NO ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS.**

#### **RV PARKING**

#### **DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE**

From North or South (Saratoga Springs): take Exit 14 of I-87 (Northway) and follow the signs for Rte 29, east. Go 9 miles on Rte 29 to Schuylerville. Take a right at Cumberland Farms. Go 0.3 miles to the light and take a left at the light, following Rte 29. You will pass the Washington County Fairgrounds. 2.7 miles past the fairgrounds, take a right at the Battenkill Vet Clinic onto Rte 40, south. Go 0.3 miles. Take a left onto Bulson at the Elks Club. Go 0.4 miles. Take a right onto Hegeman Bridge Road. Go 0.2 miles and turn left onto Louse Hill Road. Go 0.2 miles and turn right, up the driveway to High Goal Farm.

From South (and alternate route from South): Take Route 22 North through the towns of Petersburg and Hoosick. In Cambridge, turn left onto Route 372 West, and follow for 10 miles. Turn left on Hill Street (this is the end of Route 372, it's at a traffic light); follow for 1.4 miles (it becomes Hegeman Bridge Road). Turn left onto Louse Hill Road, follow for 0.2 miles and turn right, up the driveway to High Goal Farm.

**CPE general SpeedWay trial rules: see the online rulebook at [www.k9cpe.com](http://www.k9cpe.com) for further info on divisions and complete details.**

**General CPE rules for entries/show site:**

- Dogs must be at least 12 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class.
- No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

**Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring**

- Dogs can now run with or without a collar. Collars should preferably be quick release style, a flat buckle, rolled leather, or flea prevention. No attachment of any kind are allowed on the collar.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Handlers may carry their leash with them on the course – if done so the leash must be out of sight or clipped around the shoulders or waist.
- Dogs must be under the handler's control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10' feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.
- The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course.
