* The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

* Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.

* It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

* No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

* Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms: illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SITE

Coming from the North on I-65

Take KY-1526 W (exit 121). Turn right off of the ramp onto KY-1526 W. At the first stop SIGN turn left onto 1020 S (Coral Ridge Road). Go approximately 2 miles to Clear Run Drive. Turn right onto Clear Run Drive & Agility Cues For You will be the 2nd to the last building on your right.

Coming from the South on I-65

Take KY-1526 W (exit 121). Turn left off of the ramp onto KY-1526 W. At the first stop SIGN turn left onto 1020 S (Coral Ridge Road). Go approximately 2 miles to Clear Run Drive. Turn right onto Clear Run Drive & Agility Cues For You will be the 2nd to the last building on your right.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR WARM UP AREA. THERE IS A LEASH LAW IN THE TRIAL SITE'S STATE.

Trials run smoother with your help! ☺ Please sign up to work. A worker sign-up form will be at the trial. We offer a nice worker raffle. Don't worry if you don't know how to do a job! They are easy and we can show you how!

There will be plenty of crating inside. Competitors are also welcome to crate out of their vehicles. Please only bring dogs entered in the trial with you. No ex-pens unless they take up less room than a crate would. We anticipate being done in 3-4 hours.

Please bring a tarp to place under your crate.

Additional Pandemic Precautions: Please ensure that you review CPE's guidelines regarding the pandemic PRIOR to entering the trial. We WILL be following the most up to date guidelines put out by CPE. We will also be following all state guidelines and requirements related to mask-wearing and crowds gathering.

Refunds: Bitches in season and injured dogs should not compete in agility trials. Refund of entry fees for injured dogs or bitches entered in the trial that come in season after the closing date of this trial may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the trial secretary before the start date of the trial. Entry fees will be refunded less \$5.00 per run. Unfortunately, we are only able to provide these refunds for bitches in season and injured dogs. We are not able to provide refunds due to other reasons for which one must withdraw after the closing date, unless there is a waiting list for the trial.

Please double check the total amount due before writing your check. Any over-payments in the amount of \$10 or less will NOT be refunded

CPE general SpeedWay trial rules: see the online rulebook at www.k9cpe.com for further info on divisions and complete details.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 12 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class.
- No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: collars, stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog's eyes. **Exception – Drag Race: a flat collar with nothing attached, is allowed to facilitate the catching of the dog at the end of the run.**
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.
- Handlers may carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, the leash must be in a pocket, out of sight of the dog.
- Dogs must be under the handler's control when leaving the ring
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10' feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.
- The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course.
